Her heart felt like a caged bird, caught in her hurt, caught in her sadness.




Her friend's heart felt like a caged bird, too, caught in her mean words.

She was crabby. She was a crabby panda.




Bene decided to speak with her friend.

Something magical happened ...


Bene felt her heart set free.
